FGD Content analysis

The FGD's activity in the Community Radio of Baucau run well and most of the participants were students of SOLS and young people, there were 70% of them didn't listen to radio, because of that before starting the FGD process, they played the episode on Domestic violence. Then the facilitator started to ask the questions. For some participants, Domestic Violence always happens in their environment. Because of the mentality that men have they think that men are one who rule the family because men provide bride price and also look for food (working).

Success Story

Participants were serious and interested in participated this program and they were happy because this was as a guideline to prevent DV to happen in their environment.

In The FGD in Baucau, the participants promised that they will share this information to other people that DV is a public crime and there is no tolerance, and there was one participant will implement is and if he finds other people committed the DV, he will report it to the police. The other participant also mentioned that, he/she just knew that DV is public crime and he/she will not agree if this problem has to overcome through the way of Non Formal Justice.

Participants' Suggestion

They requested to implement this program in the rural area because injustice cases mostly happen in the rural area.

Next step

- The FGD should also involve the victims and the actors of DV.
- Need to implement it in the rural area
- Use the maternal language
- Need to work together with the Police and court in order to facilitate this case to be processed quickly
- Must be active in Campaigning.
