## **FGD Content analysis**

After listening to the program, one participant promised to share his land to his son and daughter.

### Participants' Suggestion

It is suggested to run this program in the rural area because many people in rural area don't have it. They also mentioned that they have no radio monitor to access to. They requested to SFCG to distribute it to the community members so that they can listen to the radio programs.

#### Next step

- Participants requested to produce more programs on Justice.
- To be more active in campaigning to get many people know about this program.
- It is a must to use Waimua dialect to get all people understand the program.
- Teach to the students at the Junior High and Senior High School.
